## Council Size

Following public consultation on Council size, which ended on the 18 July, the Boundary Committee for England has confirmed that they are minded to accept the submission from the One Cornwall Implementation Executive that there should be 123 councillors for the new unitary authority.

Unfortunately, at the same time, the Committee has announced that it will not be able to complete the work necessary to implement the proposed changes by the elections scheduled for May or June 2009 which therefore means that elections will have to proceed on the basis of 82 for the new authority.

Members and officers will now consider carefully the implications of this announcement; in the meantime, the Boundary Committee will begin a 12 week consultation on the draft detailed scheme for 123 electoral divisions.

## One-Stop-Shops

**At its meeting on the 31 July the Implementation Executive decided where the first phase of one-stop-shops (22 in total) will be located on 1 April 2009**

Detailed work was undertaken to identify suitable properties for these one-stop-shops. This included a survey on appropriate properties which considered disabled access, the developing role of libraries, utilising District, County and town council freehold property where at all possible, parking, public transport and cost.

In each of the 22 towns suitable buildings have been identified (list overleaf). Detailed work is now taking place to finalise the plans for these new facilities.

These 22 sites represent the first phase of the process, with the second involving outreach services and the one-stop-shop concept being extended to include mobile services to villages and rural communities.
